



This notice describes how medical information about you may be used and disclosed and how you can get access to this information. Please review it carefully.

WHO WILL FOLLOW THIS NOTICE

We are required by law to maintain the privacy of protected health information, to provide you with a notice of our legal duties and the information privacy practices followed by our organization and its workforce members, and to notify affected patients following a breach of unsecured protected health information. We are required to abide by the terms of this notice of privacy practices (this "notice") currently in effect.

This notice applies to the information we have about your health, health status, and the health care services you receive from our organization.

Treatment—Your health information may be used by our workforce members or disclosed to other health care professionals for the purpose of evaluating your health, diagnosing medical conditions and providing treatment. For example, we may disclose your health information to doctors, nurses, technicians, or other workforce members who are involved in taking care of you and your health.

Health care operations—We may use and disclose health information about you in order to run the organization and make sure that you and our other patients receive quality care. For example, we may use your health information to evaluate the performance of our workforce members in caring for you. We may also use health information about all or many of our patients to help us decide what additional services we should offer, how we can become more efficient, or whether certain new treatments are effective.

Treatment alternatives—We may tell you about or recommend possible treatment options or alternatives that may be of interest to you.

Fundraising by hospital or related foundation—We, or our related hospital foundation Astria Health Foundation, may, from time to time, contact you about donating for purposes such as increasing the treatment capability of our hospital.

SPECIAL SITUATIONS
We may use or disclose health information about you without your permission for the following purposes, subject to all applicable legal requirements and limitations:

Research—We may use and disclose health information about you for research projects that are subject to a special approval process. We will ask you for your permission if the researcher will have access to your name, address or other information that reveals who you are, or will be involved in your care at our hospital or its other facilities.

Military, veterans, national security and intelligence—If you are or were a member of the armed forces, or part of the national security or intelligence communities, we may be required by military command or other government authorities to release health information about you. We may also release information about foreign military personnel to the appropriate foreign military authority.
